Health: This health history is correct as far as I know. I give my permission for the camp first aid provider to treat the above listed student in the event of a minor illness or minor injury. IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, and when I am unable to be contacted, I hereby give permission to the local physician selected by the camp to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, order injection, anesthesia, or surgery for my child.

Activities: I understand that by signing this form that I am giving permission for the listed student to participate in all scheduled activities. Every activity sponsored by the KYM A/G is carefully planned and adequately supervised. However, even with the best of planning and precaution, unseen events can occur. By signing this form the parent or guardian agrees to assume and accept all risks and hazards inherent in event-related activities including; death, injury, illness, and damage associated with such risks.

Off Camp Crestwood: I give permission for my student to be taken off Camp Crestwood for service projects. The student will ride with his/her youth leader. If his/her youth leader is not participating in this event, he/she will be paired up with another youth leader who is participating.

Insurance: The Camp Insurance is secondary coverage with a maximum benefit of \$5,000.00 per incident. All claims made will need to be filed with the individual's insurance provider first. Camp insurance is supplemental and covers expenses the individual's insurance does not cover. Camp insurance only covers accidents that happen while the individual is at camp. The family will bear the full responsibility for charges related to causes other than accidents, or charges not covered by, or beyond the \$5,000.00 maximum of the camp insurance.

Pictures & Videos: We authorize the KYM to use our student's likeness in photographs or video in any and all of its publications and media. We will make no monetary or other claims against the District for the use of such photos or videos.

Admission: It is the policy of the KYM and Kentucky Youth Alive to admit all persons without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. The same requirement for admission is applied to all persons without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. There is no distinction of eligibility for or in the manner of providing services by this agency. All facilities of the agency are available regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, or handicap. G5 DISCIPLESHIP WEEKEND INFORMATION & POLICY

Registration Fees:

Early-Bird Registration \$49.00 (if paid in full 2 weeks early)

Deposit Registration \$19.00 (\$19 deposit 2 weeks early with balance (\$40) of tuition paid at check-in)

Housing: Students must supply their own bedding. Roommates (in most cases) will be determined by the secretary. Please utilize the space provided on the Student Registration form to express your rooming preferences. While every attempt is made to grant requests, we cannot guarantee every request. Thank you for your understanding.

Dress Policy: All students are expected to dress and groom themselves neatly and modestly. Inappropriate clothing (such as those with alcohol, tobacco, satanic and sexual slogans) is not permitted. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times. Clean clothing, not recreation attire, is to be worn to the evening service. All clothing, recreation attire must be modest.

Visits and Calls: Our retreat is closed to individuals not registered as a student or staff. This is for the safety and protection of all students at our facility.

Can I Instruct My Student To Call Home: Phone calls in/out are not permitted during the weekend. All cell phones should be left home or in the vehicle they arrived in. As a part of our policy, all electronic devices are prohibited.

Opening and Closing of our retreat: Retreat check-in begins Friday 7:00 PM & dismisses at 12:00 AM on Sunday. ***Students will not be allowed access to the campgrounds until after check-in.***

What to Bring: Bedding, pillow, pajamas, recreational clothing, jeans/modest shorts, current medications, spending money, Bible, socks & undergarments, personal toiletries, sweatshirt, bug spray, towel, sturdy shoes for rough terrain, notebook & pencil, plastic bag for dirty clothing, sun screen.

What not to Bring: Electronic equipment including radios, personal music players, MP3 players, iPods, video game equipment, water balloons & guns, knives, fireworks, firearms, tobacco, weapons, alcohol, drugs, pets, cell phones, cookware, food.

Spending Money: The Manna Hut (snack shop) is open during free times for the purchase of food, beverages, and souvenirs. Students may wish to bring cash for the Manna Hut and Store and offering for STL.

G5 DISCIPLESHIP WEEKEND INFORMATION & POLICY CONTINUED...

Lost & Found: Please mark your student's belongings. It is the student's responsibility to check the office for lost items. A fee will be charged to ship lost and found articles. Lost and found items are kept only 30 days following and then are donated to charity.

Medications: All medications are to be turned in to the first aid provider upon arrival. All medications brought to the retreat shall be clearly labeled to include: 1) student's name, 2) name of prescribing physician, 3) prescription number, 4) date prescribed, 5) name of medication, 6) directions for use.

Rules & Regulations: We should strive at all times to represent Christ well as Christians with proper consideration of others. Attendance at all scheduled events; morning sessions, recreation, meals, and the evening services are required. Room and grounds are to be kept clean and tidy. Students must take care of property. Students are responsible to pay for damage to their room and dorm. **If an offender cannot be found**, the cabin members will be charged equally. Students are not to enter another cabin without the leader's permission. Students must be in bed and quiet by "lights out."

Disciplinary Action: No student shall leave the grounds or go out of bounds without proper permission from the director. The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property or authority, leaving dorms/rooms at night after lights out, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any student will result in **discipline and/or expulsion** from the retreat. Parents are asked to help in explaining these rules to their student and encouraging their compliance. Expense of transporting expelled student home must be borne by the parents.
